day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine
hundred and thirty-nine.

I HEREBY revoke all Wills made by me at any time heretofore. I appoint
my niece Hildegard Marie Stock of the Norfolk Hotel S.W.1
and my step daughter, Rose Greetham Buddin of Brunel Fleet Bank
to be my Executors, and direct that all my Debts and Funeral Expenses shall be paid as soon as conveniently may be
after my decease. I also appoint these two Executrices to be my Trustees.

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH unto

My Trustees upon Trust all my real and personal estate to sell, call in
and convert the same into money (with power to postpone the sale, calling in
and conversion of any part of my real or personal estate for such
period as they may in their absolute discretion deem fit, without
being liable to account, notwithstanding that it may be of a wasting
speculative or reversionary nature) and after payment thereof
of my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses, to stand
possessed of the proceeds of such sale and conversion and all
parts of my estate for the time being unsold (hereinafter called my
residuary estate)

(A) as to one fifth part or share thereof, in trust for my stepson
Richard Edgo Buddin of Claverton Helensburgh Scotland, or if he
shall die in my lifetime for his wife, Christina, for her lifetime
and afterwards for their children in equal parts (except any of
such children as shall have entered or shall enter a Relinquents
order). Should the widow re-marry, she will be entitled only to an
equal share with the children for her life-time.

(B) as to one fifth part or share in Trust for my stepson Cuthbert
Peter Buddin of Whangarei, New Zealand, or if he shall die in
my lifetime, as to three fifth parts of such fifth part or share
upon Trust for the widow for her lifetime and afterwards in
equal parts to their children. Should the widow re-marry

(D) as to one fifth part or share thereof my wife Isabelle Marie Lumb

(wife Stock) wife - Herbert Kenneth Lumb of Walsley, Cheshire, or if she shall die in my lifetime, then as to three fifths of such fifth part in equal shares to her husband & her two boys, John Cottell Lumb R.A.F. and Richard Noel Walter Lumb, the boys to receive their share only when my trustee think desirable but in no case before the age of 25 years - The remaining two fifths parts of such fifth part, to my wife Hildegarde Marie Stock -

(E) as to the remaining one fifth part or share thereof, as to one fifth of such part to my step daughter & trustee, Rose Greetham Butler, whom I know to be otherwise provided for - as to one fifth of such part to my stepson Edward Butler, to be held in trust for his lifetime only - as to one fifth of such fifth part, my niece Mildred Emily Cottell, to be held in trust for her life only - This legacy only, to be free of death duties -
